



ANNUAL TUITION FEES APPLICABLE FROM AUGUST 2025 – 26 The school fees at the Bishop Mackenzie International School are structured according to the student's age (Primary, Secondary, and Diploma) and the parents' tax status. Those parents subject to Malawi taxation are considered taxpayers, others are considered as non-taxpayers.

<p>CLASSES</p> <p>Primary: Pre-K to Grade 5 Secondary: Grade 6 to Grade 10 IB Diploma: Grade 11 and Grade 12</p>	<p>OTHER FEES</p> <p>Examination entry fees for IB Diploma (Grade 12) are payable by parents at the rate set by the examination authorities. Field trips are charged at cost, as are some voluntary activities where outside facilities or professional coaches are used.</p>
<p>STUDENTS JOINING AND LEAVING DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR</p> <p>Students joining or leaving at any time of the month shall be liable to a full fee installment for that particular month (or the preceding month in case of non-invoicing months).</p>	<p>OTHER EXPENSES:</p> <p>a. Cafeteria School cafeteria services are operated by Aretha Thornicroft from Black Pepper.</p> <p>b. Uniforms Uniforms will be available from the uniform shop from the beginning of the academic year.</p> <p>The uniform has not changed. Golf shirt tops and navy blue shorts/trousers/skirts.</p>
<p>ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE</p> <p>An annual registration fee of US\$120 (or equivalent) is payable per individual student. This is non-refundable and will be invoiced with Term 1 fees. A book deposit of US\$50 (or equivalent) per student is payable on enrolment. This is refundable (in Malawi Kwacha at the prevailing school rate and less any outstanding charges for lost or damaged equipment) on receipt of the completed checklist of books and equipment.</p>	
<p>TAX</p> <p>Taxpayer parents are those subject to Malawi income taxation on the income that is used to pay school fees. Non-Taxpayer parents have tax-free status in Malawi. Determination of this shall be based on the principal earner's income i.e. the parent who is the main reason for relocating to Malawi.</p>	
<p>FEES: GENERAL INFORMATION</p> <p>Tuition fees are based on costs for a whole year and are calculated in US\$. From August 2013, a system of "monthly" billing has been in place to help spread payments for families and to avoid the inconvenience and additional administration of arranging ad-hoc repayment terms where temporary cash flow made the payment of termly fees difficult for some families.</p> <p>Annual fees are invoiced in nine equal installments spread over the period of the academic year. All fees are invoiced in Malawi Kwacha and are due on or before the dates specified in the invoice dates schedule below.
