

BMIS MYP EQUIPMENT LIST

- A robust school bag (lockers are available for hire).
- Stationery: black/blue writing pen(s); 2HB pencil(s) (for graphs/tables); ruler; highlighters; scissors; glue; eraser.
- A device (laptop/tablet). BMIS has a BYOD (bring your own device) policy, and students are able to connect one device to the school's Wi-Fi. Students are encouraged to bring their devices each day. Devices can be used to conduct research, complete classwork, access ManageBac/Google docs/Google Classroom, and task sheets. Laptops are more appropriate than a tablet, because of their keyboard, software availability, and the ability to use a USB/memory stick to share and save files. We have a set of laptops and iPads in the Secondary School Office, which teachers/students can loan during lessons if necessary.
- Concertina/expanding file. This is particularly helpful for our younger students who are developing their organisational skills. They can use a different section for each of their subjects, and keep their workbook and handouts/resources all together.



- Casio Scientific calculator. It must be able to display fractions properly so we suggest Fx 82, 83, 84, 85.
- *Please note that we provide students with class workbooks.*
